

Volunteering with Catch 22

Catch 22 in East Sussex are recruiting for exciting and interesting volunteering roles working with young people and vulnerable adults. Our volunteers perform a variety of roles for which they are trained, supported and supervised. These include Mentoring a young person who needs a role model in their life, acting as Appropriate Adults for children or vulnerable adults in custody and working alongside the police to make contact with young runaways and support them once found.

Many of the young people we work with have either offended or are at risk of offending and all are in some way vulnerable. We work very closely with the Police, the Youth Offending Team and Children's Services in delivering these projects.

Previous experience is not essential as full training will be given. Time commitments are dependent on the project and your availability. CRB and references will be sought. You must be over the age of 18 to volunteer in any of these roles.

Catch 22 volunteers should be non-judgemental, good communicators and be committed to promoting the welfare of children and vulnerable adults. If you think this sounds like you and you are a reliable and committed individual then we would like to hear from you.
